



# **Massey University Teaching Gym**

(Green Box in picture)



- 2 courts (numbered 20 & 21)
- Maximum capacity of 8 team vans (1 per team) to park in the small car park behind the Rec Centre. Marked in orange. No parking meter ticketing required.
- Any remaining attendees can utilise that parking by the Hockey Turf (marked in red.) Free of charge. No parking meter ticketing required.
- o Teams or spectators may park in the ticketed parking at their own cost.

The competition will be delivered with a draw format of waves as outlined below.

- Teams split into morning and afternoon groups. Will play and do their duties within their group session. The benefit of this is the removal of the need to be at the stadium for the full day or extended periods. This will mean there are times when a team has to do duty and then play (no break).
- Check draw as waves will be affected by crossovers
  - Division I/II Tuesday afternoon
  - Divisions III+ Wednesday afternoon


Ice is available in all venues

- Tournament Team and MVP will be selected by VNZ Junior National Team Coaching Staff onsite for the event

# **Duty Team Requirements**

- Duty teams consist of 1st & 2nd Referee, scorer, assistant scorer and 2 line judges
- 1st Referee must have at least the Local Referee Qualification
- An adult must be present during duty fulfilling one of the duty roles wearing a fluorescent vest or a VNZ Referee top at all times
  - For health & safety the duty adult or school to supply their own fluorescent vest
- Scoresheets are to be fully completed (which includes all signatures and the totals in the results section)
- Maximum of 2 duty members at the score bench
- No headphones or earbuds in or phones in hand while on duty

#### **Team Uniforms**

- Team shirt and shorts must be matching in design and colour (except the Libero). Shirt numbers must be clearly visible and numbered front and back.
- Libero tops must be a distinctly contrasting colour from the team top and numbered front and back.

## The Official Team Area

• Only players and coaching staff listed on the scoresheet are permitted to be on the team bench during match play.

#### Broadcast

- VNZ will follow the Charter on the Broadcast and Sponsorship of Secondary School Sport
- Only certain courts will be streamed: 2024: Courts 1-4 (Division I)
  - If a school or team does not want to be streamed they will contact VNZ and VNZ will ensure streaming is turned off for their games
