LOAN FORMS

Division 1 teams may loan 1 player from a non-qualified Division 1 team within the loan window. Division 2 teams may loan 1 player from a non-qualified Division 1, 2 or 3 team.

Loans are only granted at the discretion of the loaning club. Clubs, Associations and Players are not allowed to charge Transfer and Loan Fees.

Seedings are attached to this email (Midlands seeding to follow). Email me if there are any changes to your team entries. Draft draws will be available on Monday.

UNIFORMS

We request that teams send a photo of their playing kit by **Wednesday, 27 September** to ensure that all are the same. By informing VNZ ahead of time, we reduce the number of uniform issues and sanctions during the tournament and can focus on playing the game. **Uniforms are both tops and bottoms and should be matching in design and colour.**

Uniform tops should be the same design and colour. Uniform numbers must be clearly visible front and at the back and numbered from 1-99. Although specified in the Manual, we do not require the captain's shirt to be identified with a line, but we highly recommend that this is followed.

The libero must wear a uniform top that is in distinct COLOUR CONTRAST to shirts worn by other members of the team and must be recognized from all angles as being in clear contrast to and distinct from the other members of the team. It is recommended that the libero's uniform is a different top in colour and design.

Uniform bottoms must be the same in colour and design. Small logos are allowed but big visible logos and stripes are not allowed unless all players wear the same shorts. The length must be the same for all players.
